## **N-acetyl-L-cysteine, Enzymes from fermented maltodextrins, Vitamin C and Riboflavin**

Granules for oral extemporaneous suspension with fructose and sweetener

**Ingredients:** Fructose; N-acetyl-L-cysteine; Vitamin C (L-ascorbic acid); Aromas; Acidifier: citric acid; Enzymes from fermented maltodextrins; Anti-caking agent: silicon dioxide; Bulking agents: hydroxypropylmethylcellulose, microcrystalline cellulose; Sweetener: acesulfame K; Vitamin B2 (riboflavin).

**Packaging and content:** 20 sachets, each containing 3 g of granules for extemporaneous oral suspension.

**VISCOFLU®** contains N-acetyl-L-cysteine associated to enzymes derived from the controlled fermentation of maltodextrins through *Aspergillus oryzae* and *Aspergillus melleus*, with Vitamin C and riboflavin, vitamins useful to help and protect cells from oxidative stress and, respectively, to contribute to the efficiency of the immune system and to support the correct function of mucosa.

### **Recommended dose:**

Children >3 years: 1 sachet per day.

Adults: 2 sachets per day.

**Instruction for use:** dissolve the content of the sachet in a glass of water and stir well.

**Warnings:** do not give **VISCOFLU®** to children under 3 years. Do not exceed the recommended daily dose. Keep out of reach of children under three years.

Food supplements are not intended as substitutes for a balanced and varied diet and healthy lifestyle.

**Storage conditions:** store at room temperature (not higher than 25° C), avoid exposure to localized heat sources and humidity. The expiry date refers to the product unopened, properly stored.

**Notice:** the presence of dark-colored residues in the suspension does not indicate an alteration of the product.
